INSTALLATION

1 OEM STEP REMOVAL


If equipped, remove the OEM steps or sliders from the vehicle.

2 TEMPLATE AND DRILL

1/4" - 20 X 3/4" Button Head Bolt

1/4" - 20 Nyloc Nut


Hold the rocker guards up in place and align with the OEM openings. Mark the locations near the openings and trace the outline. Drill top these locations to fit 3/8" hardware. Drill the underside location to fit 1/2" hardware



TREAD PLATE INSTALLATION Install the tread plates on the rocker guards using the provided 1/4" hardware. DRIVERS SIDE SHOWN

A ROCKER GUARD MOUNTING

Place the provided nut retainers into each access opening for mounting later (the opening will be constricted by clipnuts). Attach provided clip nuts to the drilled locations as shown. Attach the rocker guard to the under side of the vehicle and mount using the provided 3/8" and 1/2" bolt hardware.





5 HARDWARE

Check that all hardware has been installed. Once complete align and adjust the rocker guards as need. **TIGHTEN ALL HARDWARE.**

CHECK HARDWARE REGULARLY AND TIGHTEN AS NEEDED, INCLUDING AFTER OFFROAD USE.
